Thursday, September 6th

- Starting 10.00 am, launching of the boats in the harbor of Fallenbach near Brunnen. www.fwag.ch
- Until 4.00 pm Official boats control by the lake police of Schwyz
- Around 6.00 pm first come together with a Aperitivo
- Starting 7.00 pm dinner at the port restaurant «Beaufort»

Friday, September 7th

- 11.00 am Meeting point at the Restaurant Riva in Weggis (about 40 minutes boat crossing time)
- 02.00 pm crossing and cruising to the shipyard SGV in Lucerne
 On the way you will visit various nautical attraction like: Sündenbucht; Opferstock
 St. Nicklaus on the lake.
- ETA at 3.00 pm at the shipyard where we will dock and leave the boats. By foot we will visit the old town and city center of Lucerne. Back to the shipyard and after a guided tour of the SGV shipyard, we will enjoy a rustic Swiss dish on the shipyard area. We will return cruising at sunset to Brunnen via Weggis.

Saturday, September 8th

- Meeting point at the restaurant Riva in Weggis, the headquarter of the wooden boat club of the Vierwaldstattersee (lake of 4 Cantons)
- final «gala» evening with a SURPRISE

Sunday, September 9th

- Joint breakfast at the Hotel Waldstätterhof in Brunnen, followed by retrieving the boats and hauling out of the water.
- End of organized event.

Expected are between 10 and 20 Riva boats from Europe, built between 1950 and 1985. Participation is restricted to only 20 boats (first in, first served based after reservation entrance).
